What is Kidz Board?



The **Kidz Board** are a group of young wheelchair users, who are proud to each represent a different area of the UK.

We meet up several times a year, in person or online, and our job is to make sure our voices, and young people from our areas, are at the heart of every decision Whizz-Kidz makes.

We're passionate about raising awareness of the issues that affect us every day and we campaign to make a real difference for all young wheelchair users.





What do the Kidz Board do?

We want to challenge perceptions and raise awareness of issues that affect young wheelchair users every day, such as our manifesto topics: **Education, Employment, Travel, Accessibility**.

We consult with key businesses, industry leaders, charities, and community groups to campaign, raise awareness, undertake access audits and focus groups, highlight areas for improvement and collaborate on projects to influence solutions.

We also join advisory boards in a variety of sectors to ensure representation.

What will I need to do?

- Attend four residential Kidz Board meetings a year, usually Friday to Sunday. Often in London, Whizz Kidz pay for travel, food and accommodation for you and for one parent, guardian or carer. If you are over 18 and don't require overnight healthcare support, you may be able to attend Kidz Board on your own following a risk assessment taking place.
- Join monthly zoom calls and join in project work as decided in the Kidz Board strategy. This could include writing a blog, representing Whizz Kidz at an event or raising awareness of the charity through project work.
- Represent Whizz Kidz on social media, either using your own social media channels or providing content for Whizz Kidz's social media channels such as new ideas, blogs and videos.





Eligibility

- Be aged 16-25 at the time of your first meeting.
- Be a wheelchair user.
- Be passionate and motivated about making a difference to the lives of wheelchair users in the UK.
- · Agree to adhere to the Whizz Kidz Kidz Board Agreement.
- Be hardworking, and able to commit the time to attend meetings and activities.
- Have excellent communication skills, to have regular contact with other Kidz Board members, and with members of staff at Whizz Kidz.
- Have an email address which you check regularly. We will send you email on a regular basis and expect that you will read and reply to all emails.

- 2. Kidz Board members and Whizz Kidz staff will review your application anonymously.
- 3. Sometimes we may have lots of applicants or a position isn't immediately available. It's okay to apply again another time.
- 4. We may ask you to attend an online interview.
- 5. If after the interview a position is offered, you will be invited to join Kidz Board at the next meeting.
